Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

This CR aims at keeping the GUI Business Functionality Document consistent with the T2S User Handbook, in particular to reflect significant changes made to the T2S GUI as part of recently implemented change requests, or change requests under implementation for T2S release 5.0.

Description of requested change:

It is proposed to amend the BFD document as described, with revision marks, in the annex to this CR. The changes can be summarised as follows:

- Referencing of business functions in 13 new areas related to the T2S penalty mechanism (CR-654)
- Updates to the hold/release business functions (CR-653)
- Updates to the technical annex on software requirements and digital signature (CR-722)
- Update to the description of the T2S cash forecast (clarification note CRG-PBR-0022)
