Migration from SWIFT Browse to SWIFT WebAccess

SWIFT migration from Browse to WebAccess

- SWIFT release 7.2, implemented in November 2018, no longer supports Browse service and applet technology.
- In addition to this, SWIFT announced to end the support for all SWIFT releases 7.0.x and 7.1.x by end of 2019
- Consequently, all SWIFT users will need to migrate from Browse to WebAccess by end of 2019 in order to be able to access financial services over SWIFT web portals.

TARGET2 adaptation to migration to WebAccess

- The access to TARGET2 will change from Browse to WebAccess with the installation of TARGET2 release 13.0 on 18 November 2019.
- All TARGET2 participants will have to migrate to WebAccess as of 18 November 2019 in order to be able to access TARGET2 ICM (U2A).
- The impact on users should be limited to a potential change of the URL used for accessing TARGET2. However, this still needs to be confirmed by SWIFT.
