Thank you for your letter on the ECB's IT services, which was passed on to me by Ms Aurore Lalucq, Chair of the Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs, accompanied by a cover letter dated 31 March 2025.

The ECB maintains a rigorous risk management framework to protect its information and the data entrusted to it by third parties. Within this framework, sensitive information is protected by several layers of security controls, including encryption, which are actively monitored and regularly tested to ensure they can respond effectively to the respective threat environment.

The ECB's unified communication and collaboration services (including email) are currently provided by BT GmbH & Co. oHG, and its telecommunication lines and services are provided by Colt Technology Services GmbH. Telekom Deutschland GmbH provides the ECB's mobile communication services (SIM card and related services).
